Claudio Ronco graduated in medicine from the University of Padua, Italy, in 1976. In 1979, he specialized in nephrology at the University of Padua, and in 1989, he specialized in pediatric nephrology at the University of Naples.

In 1999 and 2000 he has been Director of the Renal Laboratory of research at the Renal Research Institute of New York and Professor of Medicine at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine and Beth Israel Medical Center of New York. Since 2002, he has been Director of the Department of Nephrology of St Bortolo Hospital, Vicenza, Italy. Professor Ronco co-authored 1486 papers, 132 book chapters and 84 books, and he delivered more than 950 lectures at international meetings and universities. He has been council member of several scientific societies. He is editor emeritus of the International Journal of Artificial organs, and he is Editor-in-Chief of *Blood Purification*, *Cardiorenal Medicine* and *Contributions to Nephrology*. Professor Ronco has received numerous honours and awards, including, in 2004, a lifetime achievement award, honorary membership of the Spanish Society of Nephrology, the National Kidney Foundation International Medal of Excellence and the ISN Bywaters Award for Acute Renal Failure, Honorary Degree at the University of Patras.
